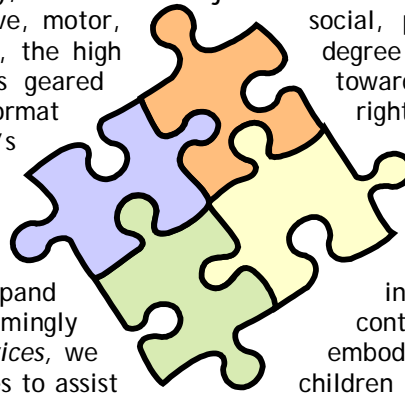


# Applied Behavior Analysis Programs
